1. What about World Series or All-Star Play?

Pony holds season ending all-star play. As in the past, the board will work to identify coaches for all-stars and offer additional play in the divisions that show readiness to compete.

2. I live in Illinois or Wisconsin, what am I allowed to play?

Everything – you are welcome here. Our affiliation allows us to expand our charter reach to the tri-state neighbors that want to play baseball in Dubuque. This includes all-star play.

40% of our tee-ball level enrollment is girls. Some girls continue promoting through the league, but it tends to diminish as they age. Partnership with the city has expanded our access to fields, so our target is to expand the league to include softball for 2017.
